

Consultation and Advocacy for prevention and empathetic management of sexual violence

Enfold has been in the field of prevention and management of child sexual abuse since its inception in 2002. With extensive training and field experience Enfold has amassed enormous learnings in this field. It actively engages with State and National level teams to improve the implementation of just and child friendly policies, protocols and processes. A few are listed here:

In Karnataka

- a. Enfold completed a study on the Implementation of POCSO in Karnataka for the Department of Women and Child Development, in August 2017. This captured the findings and challenges of 98 families, 94 police personnel, 32 medical personnel, 12 special public prosecutors and 14 CWC members from 10 districts in Karnataka.
- b. Enfold worked with organizations for the Department of Women and Child Development, Karnataka to develop a Child Protection Policy
- c. Enfold's founder, Dr Sangeeta Saksena (also a B-SAFE representative) is a member of the Karnataka Government Committee to suggest amendments to laws pertaining to safety of women and children, constituted in July 2014 by the Home Department, Government of Karnataka.

In Jharkhand:

- a. Enfold is working with UNICEF in Jharkhand to assess the need for training on POCO and gender sensitization
- b. Enfold is working with UNICEF in Jharkhand to set up a Child Friendly Court in Ranchi and train Medical, Police and Judicial Personnel as well as a cadre of Support Persons under the POCSO Act. (2017 - 2018)

In Manipur: Enfold is working in Imphal with JINMS and Department of Justice, Min of Law and Justice, to Train Trainers on roles and responsibilities under POCSO and Personal Safety education. These trainers are training medical, police and judicial personnel, social workers, counsellors, teachers and journalists in this area. 2018 onwards
